 - Have the total number of credit hours earned as a part of the prescribed associates degree (program dependent) applied towards the BTAS Applied Administration-Healthcare Leadership (Online) degree. Additional transfer or prior learning credits may be considered upon transfer to UC for a maximum of 84 credit hours.
- Complete a UC Admission Application for the BTAS Applied Administration-Healthcare Leadership (Online) program (including providing official transcripts from prior attended institutions).
- Pay UC Matriculation fee.
- Students must be admitted to the University of Cincinnati Online during the duration of this agreement.
- Minimum GPA: 2.00
